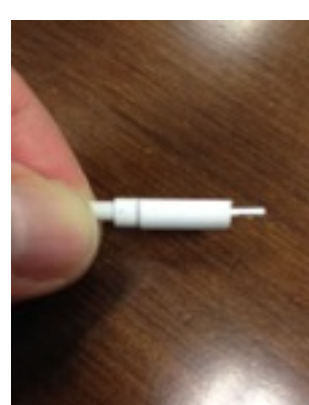
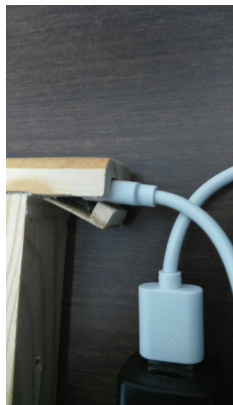




FAST START OF BEEHIVE TRACKING SYSTEM

Through this manual you can start your beehive protection system. Anyway, we recommend to read the main manual in order you know all possibilities of our tracking system.

- When you receive the box, just charge it. Wait several hours so the charge is complete. You can charge it through an external battery or through a Smartphone Android charger. **VERY IMPORTANT.** The gap to insert the charger terminal is small. Some cables have very thick terminals so the manufacturer makes them very big, sometimes it can be necessary to remove part of the plastic. See the picture on the right. If the connector does not fit into the charger zone, just remove some plastic, without reaching the metallic parts of the cable inside.



- Place the wax as usually. In Langstroth boxes, place an additional wax strip in order to cover both sides of the device. This way, when bees stretch the cells, the device will remain hidden. See this video <https://youtu.be/yGiDyTtykJc>
- Install the application CENTINELA on your Smartphone.
- Open the application CENTINELA on your Smartphone and set the user and password already assigned by us. You will find them in the documents we send along with the device. You do not need to remember it, your Smartphone will do it
- Do not use the same user and password for two different devices. If you need more devices, we will give more passwords. Remember each Smartphone needs their own user and password, they cannot be shared
- Installation has been finished
- Device will communicate in several situations (batteries running out, robbery, etc), for this purpose you must program the warnings. Instructions to do so will be found in the back of this Manual and on page 8 of the main manual. We recommend to do it immediately
- When the system communicates a robbery, you can see the itinerary by clicking on "Map" on your Smartphone application (see chapter 4) or through our website www.seguridadcentinela.com/en/ (see chapter 5).
- On top of the Map screen you can see a code. This code allows the Access of the police to all information generated.

- By introducing such code Police can follow the itinerary as you do (see page 10-11)
- Finally, if you are robbed, just keep calm and DO NOT TRY TO RECOVER YOUR BEEHIVES BY YOURSELF.
- Just report to the authorities and collaborate with them at all times REMIND the thieves can react of very violent manner.
- After any movement, device will go off on alarm (You will receive a warning). Once the device is still (you has introduced the box back to the beehive or thief has reached his destination) in 10 minutes it will stop sending locations and in two hours will go from ALARM ON to ALARM OFF. When it is ON, it will not keep sending movement warnings

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR SMARTPHONE WARNINGS

After the right installation of the application Centinela, you must customize the warnings of our Smartphone. For iOS users, they must go to “Adjustings”

Later you must go to “Notifications”, and look for the application “SeguridadCentinela” in order to activate it. Just click on “Allow warnings” “see warnings center” “sounds” “Icon globes” and “see on blocked screen” In type of warnings choose the option “warnings”. If you are Android Smartphone user, must go to “adjusts” and allow your Smartphone sends warnings through the application “SeguridadCentinela”. Generally is comes this way by default but you must be sure.
